## March Break Day Camp March 11 – 15

### Facility Profile

DreamCatcher Farm is set on **110 acres of rolling hills and sand rings**. At DreamCatcher Farm there are lots of areas to ride including **3 large 200 X 300 foot outdoor rings** and an **80 X 120 foot indoor arena** as well as **miles of trails**. Our coaches are **certified** through **Equine Canada and Sport Canada** and bring years of experience and **enthusiasm** to all the programs. We have a variety of levels of horses and ponies that we use in our programs that are **safe** but challenge the students as they progress with their **riding skills**.

### Our Philosophy

Our philosophy at **DreamCatcher Farm** is to leave our clients a little more **enriched** through **experiences** with horses. All our programs at the farm **strive** to create experiences that **develop** technical skills and are **fun**, and **educational**. Through interaction with horses, students learn not only how to ride but develop **confidence** and gain skills in **communication**, problem solving, and **leadership**.

### March Break Program

Our March Break Program is comprised of two options, our **regular camp** program and our **extreme camp** program. This will provide options for campers who want to experience riding as well as for the students already in a riding program to **enhance** their technical skills. Within each program, campers will be divided into groups depending on age and level of experience. In both programs, campers will receive two riding lessons each day to learn or **improve** their skills. The other portions of the day are allocated to **fun** activities to develop **horsemanship** and practical skills with horses. The regular camp program offers a broad overview of **theory** on horse care and horsemanship **skills**. The extreme camp is more **intense** and focused on improving the **technical** skills of the **rider**.

Cost of regular camp \$250 (+ HST) and cost of extreme camp \$300 (+ HST)

### Enhanced Horsemanship Option

During the March Break Program, we offer, at no additional charge, an option for campers early drop-off at 7 am – 9 am and later pick-up from 4 pm – 6 pm. During this time, campers can enhance their learning while helping with our horse care and management.

All programs are supervised and conducted by certified coaches.
